

Action Photography

Take 5 of each of the following types of action photography

Panning –

Motion Blur –

Stop Action –

Camera settings

Tv (Time/Shutter Priority) – allows you to pick the camera's shutter speed and auto selects aperture.

Running-Man (stop motion) – camera will choose the fastest shutter speed available based on light.

Night Scene (motion blur) – camera will choose a slower shutter and often results in blurred motion.

A tripod can be helpful to ensure only the objects in motion have blur and not the entire image from camera motion.

Composition

Rule of thirds and space can be very difficult when working with motion. Often the photographer has to shoot slightly ahead of the object.
